4. Any animal that kicks **must** wear a red ribbon on its tail at all times.
5. No horse under four years of age to be ridden.
6. Owners, Competitors and Riders are under obligation at all times when mounted to ensure that they are wearing Protective Headgear complying with Current British Standards.
7. Body Protectors are advisable in Jumping Classes.
8. Lead Rein must be attached to nose band in the Lead Rein Classes.
9. No refunds for Classes which Clash.
10. Any objections must be made as soon as possible at the Secretary's Tent. A £10.00 deposit will be required but will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
11. Suitable footwear **must** be worn at all times whilst mounted or entering the ring.
12. The Judge's decision is final.
13. Do not ride on the Grass Verges.
